Statistics	MATH 120 (GE B.4), SOC 303, KNES/HESC 349, ISDS 361A, or CAS 301/CHDV 301
Human Anatomy + Lab	KNES 191A or BIOL 361
Human Physiology + Lab	BIOL 191B or BIOL 310
Chemistry (inorganic, organic, and biochem) + Lab	CHEM 200
Microbiology + Lab	BIOL 202
ADDITIONAL REQUIRED COURSES	CSUF COURSE(S)
Introduction to Psychology / General Psychology	PSYC 101
Introduction to Sociology OR Cultural Anthropology	SOCI 101 or ANTH 102

All science prerequisite courses must be completed with a grade of ‘B-’ or higher  
All non-science prerequisite courses must be completed with a grade of ‘C’ or higher  
Cal. State Fullerton GPA and prerequisite course GPA must meet our 3.25 minimum

**This pathway is highly impacted. Space availability in this pathway varies each year, based on many other factors. In previous years there have been 10-20 spots open for students to come into the CSUF nursing major through this pathway.**
