Kathy received her Bachelor's degree from California State University, Long Beach. She then received her Master's degree and Doctorate in Public Health from the University of California, Los Angeles.

She also earned a California Secondary Teaching Credential and a California Community College Teaching Credential.



Kathy's first faculty position was a 15-year stint at Long Beach State. She came to Cal State Fullerton in 1987 with the expectation of creating CSUF's initial B.S. degree in Health Science. The degree was completed with colleague Jill English and first offered in 1991.



Kathy served as Chair of the Division of Kinesiology and Health Promotion from 2002-2005.

She was Chair of the Department of Kinesiology from 2005-2007.

And she served as the Associate Dean for the College of Health and Human Development from 2008-2013.



Kathy received national recognition for her research and program development in the area of veteran's health and employee education for the U. S. Department of Veterans Affairs.

She made over 200 presentations at conferences and workshops in this country and international conferences in Mexico, Ireland, and Germany.



Kathy's research interests included performance-based interviewing and its relationship to turnover/absentee/sick leave/grievance rates and employee satisfaction; and ambulatory care education in the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs health care facilities.

She was the principal investigator of a six-year control study exploring the relationship between payment of homecare for spinal cord injury veterans and their use of hospital services.
