## TWO-YEAR TRANSFER STUDENT ROADMAP AND CHECKLIST FOR BS IN PUBLIC HEALTH HEALTH EDUCATION & PROMOTION CONCENTRATION

120 units - Catalog Year Fall 2021 & Later

The Bachelor of Science in Public Health can be completed in four years, but to do so requires careful planning and preparation. You must average 15 units (five courses) per semester and you must plan ahead so that you will meet all requirements. You can opt to complete courses in the summer or winter session. The below plan is a sample Roadmap. Students may decide or need to switch courses from one semester to another. If you are planning to work, you should adjust your unit load accordingly.

New upper-division transfer students can complete the upper-division requirements in two years provided you have completed at least 60 transferable units, are fully GE certified, and have completed all of the lower-division Public Health courses.

## **Student Action Plan**

## Year 1

- Additional information regarding Concentrations, including declaring one, is given in PUBH 320.
- All PUBH major courses must be completed with a C- or better.
- PUBH 349 is a prerequisite for PUBH 349L and PUBH 401.
- PUBH 401 is a pre- or co-requisite for PUBH 475.
- The Upper Division Writing Requirement, select one: ENGL 301, ENGL 360, or ENGL 363 must be completed with a C or better.
- \*A single Asterisk indicates that the course taken in that GE Area is an Upper Division (300+) General Education course and that the "Upper Division units must be taken within the CSU."
- Must complete 9 units of Upper Division GEs, one from each of the following sections: B.5, C.3, and D.3.
- One course from GE Area C.3 or D.3 must double count with Cultural Diversity, GE Area Z (indicated by an asterisk\* on the Academic Advising Center's Website

- Meet with a PUBH academic advisor each semester, located in the KHS Student Success Center in KHS
  193.
- Visit the GH 123B Academic Advisement Center to review GE and graduation requirements.
- Apply for graduation, **FILE GRAD CHECK**, through your student center once you have earned 85 units and are one year from graduation.
- Maintain a minimum 2.0 GPA in all GPAs on Titan Degree Audit.

## Year 2

- PUBH 495: Internship in PUBH should be taken in your Senior Year (usually your last semester).
- Review TDA to ensure all requirements have been met and if any questions arise, meet with PUBH major advisor regarding major coursework.
- Pay graduation fees at least one semester prior to graduating.
- Attend a Mandatory In-Person Grad Check Workshop to have your Graduation Check approved.
- This degree requires a cumulative minimum of 120 units.
